### 1) METHODS OF COMPETITION

- Cut-off System shall be applied to the Poomsae Competition.
- In case of an insufficient number of Competitors in each category, a demonstration shall be carried out.
- Individual, Pair and Team Competitors should be wearing either WT-recognized
   Poomsae uniform(Dobok) or KTA Poomsae Uniform
- Team Competition
- · Number of competitor 3people (Individual (1person), Pair (2people))
- \* Team composition should be mixed gender. (No limitation on the ratio)
- \* Pair should be conducted as mixed gender.
- · Numbers from 1 to 3 will be assigned to team members and will be selected randomly.
- · Individuals and Pair players are randomly selected among the random numbers, and the match proceeds until the team match.
- \* However, in pair competition, it is mandatory to select 2nd for a female competitor and 3rd for a male competitor.
- · The team competition will be held in the order of individual, Pair, and trio teams.
- Recognized Poomsae for Under 8, 11, Cadet, Junior are to be conducted separately for Korean and Non-Koreans and to be awarded separately as well.
   (In case the number of competitors is 5 or below, the awards will be integrated)
   (Except for the above categories, competitions and awards will be integrated in division.)
- For Overall awards, results of each competition count as 1gold medal for individual division and 3 gold medals for Team division.
- 2) The competition area for Recognized Poomsae: 10m×10m

### 3) Scoring of Recognized Poomsae

- Poomsae(Individual)
- · Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.
- · Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points scored by 5 judges
- · In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of Presentation and total points(total points of all judges including highest and lowest points).
- · If it is still tied in Presentation and total points, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner.

(One Poomsae for a rematch shall be conducted to declare the winner)

- Poomsae(Team division)
- · The Team with higher scores summed up from the 1st to 3rd rounds shall win.
- · If all rounds are tied, one competitor designated by each Team representative will compete again by performing Poomsae newly selected by random electronic drawing of lots and the team with a higher score will win.
- · If it is still tied in rematch, both teams will be declared as co-winners.
- 4) Designation of Recognized Poomsae and the drawing of lots
- Two (2) Poomsae from the designated Compulsory Poomsae decided by Technical Delegate for each division must be performed for all the preliminary, semi final and final rounds for all competitions.

- A. The above is subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disgualified.
- D. Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of CHUNCHEON KOREA OPEN.

#### 2) METHODS OF COMPETITION

- All the Gyeokpa objects are provided by OC and for both preliminaries and finals use the same Gyeokpa objects.
- Competitor for Jumeok Gyeokpa and Sonnal Gyeokpa use Gyeokpa holder produced according to the predetermined standards and shapes by OC.
- 3) Scoring(Jumeok Gyeokpa, Sonnal Gyeokpa)
- After the 1 attempt, place of competitor shall be determined by the result of quantity more Gyeokpa objects broken.
- In case of a tied score, higher place shall be determined to the competitor with the large number of objects applied.
- If number of applied objects are still tied, higher place shall be determined to the one who weighs less.

### 6. OTHERS

- A. The above is subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.

### 4. METHODS OF COMPETITION

- A. Junior. Cadet. Under 11
  - Male / Female : (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category (Under 11 Category Mixed gender)
- Mixed competition between Korean and Non-Koreans
- All competitors must wear WT officially-approved Taekwondo uniform(Dobok) or KTA Poomsae Uniform
- Competitors should bring their own Mandatory Safety Equipment
- B. Color Belts Kyorugi
  - Tournament of 4 competitors for each division
- The match list will be generated according to height and weight at the venue on the day of the match.
- A tournament can be integrated when the number of competitors in each division(years or belts) is less than 4.
- No PSS is used in Color Belts Kyorugi.
- The competitions shall be separately operated for Korean and Non-Koreans.

#### 5. COMPETITION RULES

- A. Competitions shall abide by the WT Competition Rules & Interpretation in force as of January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- B. The best of three (3) system shall be applied.
- C. All competitors must wear WT officially approved equipment.
- D. **KPNP** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition. The OC will provide **KPNP** trunk PSS, head PSS and related items and equipment to the participating contestants. And All competitors should bring their own Safety Equipment. (Groin Guard, Forearm Guard, Sensing Socks, Gloves, Mouthpiece, etc.)

#### 6. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- A. Junior
- 1) From the preliminaries to the quarterfinals 1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds
- 2) From the semifinals to the finals 2 minutes x 3 rounds
- B. Cadet & Under 11
- 1 minute x 3 rounds
- C. Color belts Kyorugi
- 1 minute x 2 rounds

#### 7. WEIGH-IN

- A. Weigh-in of the Competitors shall be completed on the previous day of the pertinent competition. (Time and location will be noticed later)
- B. The competitors participating in Under 11, Cadet and Junior categories must be weighed with underwear(s) and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.
   (No weigh-in for Color-belts Kyorugi)
- C. During weigh-in the Male contestant shall wear underpants and the female contestant shall wear underpants and a brassiere. However, weigh-in may be conducted in the nude if the contestant wishes to do so.
- D. Weigh-in shall be made once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time.
- E. All competitors should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise disqualification.

### 8. OVERALL AWARDS

- A. Junior Male/Female If a team participates in more than 5 weight categories, total scores acquired by the team will be applied to the result of Overall Awards. (Only when more than 5 teams participate in each division)
- B. Cadet & Under 11 If a team participates in more than 5 weight categories, total scores acquired by the team will be applied to the result of Overall Awards. (Only when more than 5 teams participate in each division)

### 9. OTHERS

- A. The above is subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- B. All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium.
- C. If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- D. Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of CHUNCHEON KOREA OPEN.



### **INTERNATIONAL REFEREES**

- 1. The required number of International Referees shall be determined in accordance with the WT Rules.
- 2. Round trip airfare shall be the responsibility of each participating International Referee, while the Organizing Committee will cover accommodation of room and board from August 6-15.
- 3. The Organizing Committee will pay a per diem of US\$150 to participating referees for each competition day from August 8-14.
